All regular international flights operate to Colombo as scheduled, with a noticeable forward momentum in arrival of charter flights over the last 30 days. There are no restrictions on travel within the country.

Sri Lanka Tourism regularly interacts with leading local travel agents, tour operators and the Tourist Police to ensure tourists feel safe regardless of where they travel to within the country.
