India-Sri Lanka Foundation - New Delhi Secretariat Invitation for Project proposals

The India - Sri Lanka Foundation (ISLF) was established on December 28, 1998 by a Memorandum of Understanding signed between the Governments of India and Sri Lanka, with the objective of fostering Indo-Sri Lanka relations through the enhancement of economic, scientific, educational, technical and cultural cooperation and the promotion of greater understanding between the peoples of the two countries.

The ISLF invites project proposals, in the areas of Education, Art & Culture, Archaeological Studies, Agricultural Research, Science & Technology, Information Technology, Health, Development Studies, and Women's Studies. Under these areas, proposals could be submitted to the New Delhi Secretariat of the Foundation, for research projects and other educational activities at recognized institutions of learning located in India.

In addition, proposals could also be submitted for visits and exchanges involving students, scholars, academics, artists, professionals and performing artists, to participate in conference/seminars, symposia, art exhibitions, film festivals, cultural events and training workshops etc. The publication of research works on India-Sri Lanka relations in the specified fields and translating standard works of Sri Lankan literature into Indian languages and publishing them, and vice-versa are also encouraged. Individuals, institutions and groups are invited to submit proposals which would be considered during the next meeting of the Board of Directors of the ISLF.
